DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

QUIET VALLEY FARM MUSEUM CONSISTS OF THE ORIGINAL 72 ACRE HOMESTEAD PURCHASED BY JOHAN PETER ZEPER (TOPPER) IN 1765. JOHAN ZEPER AND HIS WIFE EMIGRATED FROM THE PALATINATE AND SETTLED ON THIS TRACT OF ROUGH LAND IN THE POCONO FOOTHILLS, LAND MUCH LIKE THAT WHICH THEY HAD LEFT IN EUROPE. THE FARM WAS OPERATED BY THE ZEPER'S DESCENDANTS UNTIL 1958, WHEN IT PASSED TO A PRIVATE PARTY WHO NOW OPERATE THE FARM AS A LIVING MUSEUM OF 19TH CENTURY RURAL LIFE.

STRUCTURES ON THE SITE INCLUDE:

MAIN HOUSE - CONSTRUCTED SHORTLY AFTER 1765, THE MAIN HOUSE WAS OF SQUARE LOG CONSTRUCTION BUILT ON AN EXPOSED STONE BASEMENT. THE ORIGINAL HOUSE WAS ONE STORY WITH A LOFT, BUT EARLY IN THE 19TH CENTURY ANOTHER STORY WAS ADDED. THE ORIGINAL HOUSE FEATURED A SMALL CAVE-LIKE KITCHEN WITH A BEATEN CLAY FLOOR AND AN ADJOINING EARTHEN COLD ROOM. IN 1892 AN 18 BY 11 FOOT, FRAME AND CLAPBOARD KITCHEN WING AND PORCH WERE ADDED TO THE ORIGINAL 24 BY 26 FOOT LOG HOUSE. THE HOUSE HAS UNDERGONE NO RENOVATION SINCE THEN. IT HAS NO ELECTRICITY AND NO PLUMBING, BUT IT DOES CONTAIN MOST OF THE 19TH CENTURY FURNISHINGS AND APPOINTMENTS.

SPRING HOUSE - BUILT ABOUT THE SAME TIME AS THE LOG HOUSE, THE SPRING HOUSE IS A 10 BY 12 FOOT STONE BUILDING WITH A STONE FLOOR AND SHAKE ROOF.

BARN - THE PRESENT BARN DATES FROM 1850 AND IS OF THE BANK BARN STYLE. OF FRAME CONSTRUCTION ON A STONE FOUNDATION, THE BARN MEASURES 46 BY 47 FEET. IT HAS A LARGE ENCLOSED FOREBAY WITH THREE ARCHED ENTRANCES IN THE FRONT. HERE TOO, MOST OF THE MID 19TH CENTURY FARMING IMPLEMENTS STILL REMAIN.

OTHER MID 19TH CENTURY BUILDINGS LOCATED BETWEEN THE HOUSE AND THE BARN INCLUDE A FRAME WASH HOUSE, A DRY HOUSE FOR DRYING FRUIT, AND A SMOKE HOUSE. AN ICEHOUSE, STORAGE SHED, AND WAGON SHED LIE TO THE SOUTH AND SOUTHEAST OF THE FARMHOUSE. A SMALL BRICK AND STONE BAKE OVEN AND A 1 1/2 STORY LOG CABIN (GRANNY HOUSE) ARE MODERN RESTORATIONS LOCATED A SHORT DISTANCE TO THE NORTHWEST OF THE FARM HOUSE.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

ALTHOUGH SEVERAL OF THE BUILDINGS AT THE QUIET VALLEY FARM CAN BE TRACED TO THE ORIGINAL 1765 SETTLEMENT, THE FARM AS A WHOLE IS MORE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE 19TH CENTURY. THE FARM IS SIGNIFICANT NOT ONLY BECAUSE IT HAS A COMPLETE COLLECTION OF 18TH AND 19TH CENTURY FARM BUILDINGS AND IMPLEMENTS, BUT ALSO BECAUSE IT REPRESENTS THE NOW VANISHED WAY OF LIFE OF 90% OF OUR ANCESTORS.

THE FARM IS NOW OPERATED AS A FUNCTIONING MUSEUM BY 3 GENERATIONS OF A LOCAL FARM FAMILY. WHILE OPERATED ON A PAYING BASIS, THE QUIET VALLEY FARM MUSEUM IS LACKING IN MOST OF THE ASPECTS OF 20TH CENTURY COMMERCIALISM. IT IS MUCH MORE THAN A MUSEUM. IT IS ONE OF THE FEW REMAINING EXAMPLES OF THE OLD SELF-SUFFICIENT FARM AND THE WAY OF LIFE OF THE EXTENDED FAMILY THAT IT SHELTERED.
