Distinguishing Features:

The Snyder Covered Bridge is 60.2 feet long, with a roadway width of 14.75 feet, and clearance of 11 feet. It is of the Queen Post design.

The roof is of corrugated galvanized steel over wooden ribs which cross the rafters. The southwestern portal is destroyed from the passage of an oversized vehicle. The opposite portal consists of plain vertical boards.

The southeasterly wall consists of vertical planks with spaces left between the planks. The opposite wall consists of a variety of designs. Part of the wall consists of horizontal siding of the overlapping type, and part consists of vertical planks which are fitted closely together.

The floor consists of horizontal boards with one wide runway on top. The undergirding has no steel beams added to it.

The abutments have been completely repaired with concrete.

Distinguishing
Features:

The southwestern portal and a portion of the roof are completely destroyed from the passage of an oversized vehicle.

The southeasterly wall has a uniform design of vertical planks with spaces left between the planks.

The opposite wall consists of horizontal siding of the overlapping type, and of vertical planks which are fitted together more closely than those on the other wall.

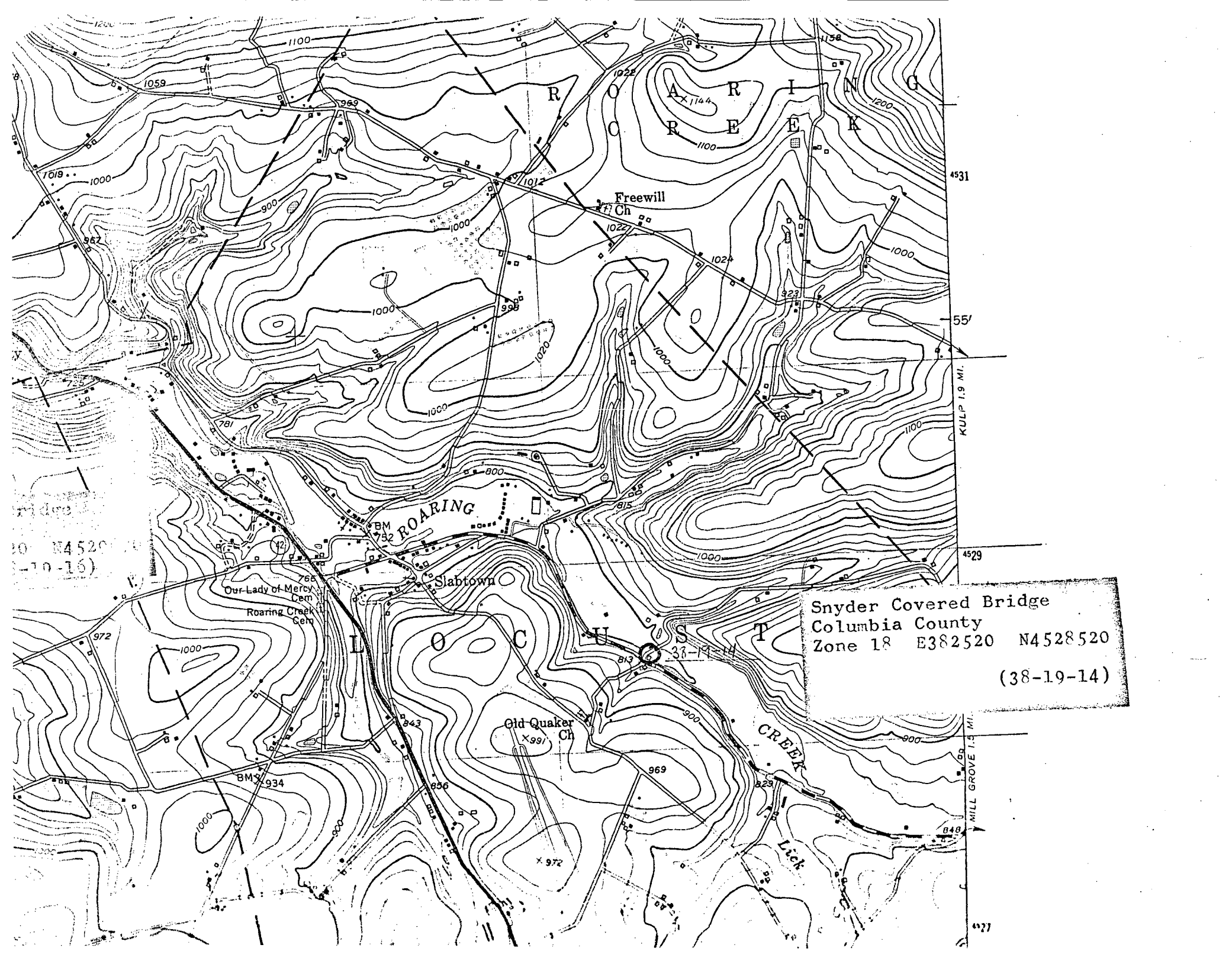
The deck consists of horizontal boards with one wide runway.

Condition:

The whole structure is in excellent condition except for the damaged portal and portion of the roof.

The undergirding consists of simple horizontal beams with no steel added.

Both of the original abutments have been replaced by reinforced concrete.
