Distinguishing Features:

Constructed in 1841, Bogerts Bridge along with Wehr's are the oldest remaining covered bridges in Lehigh County. Today this bridge is located within a city park and was restored by the Allentown Park Department. It has vertical plank siding, a gable roof and large stone abutments. Two concrete piers were added to help support the bridge.
