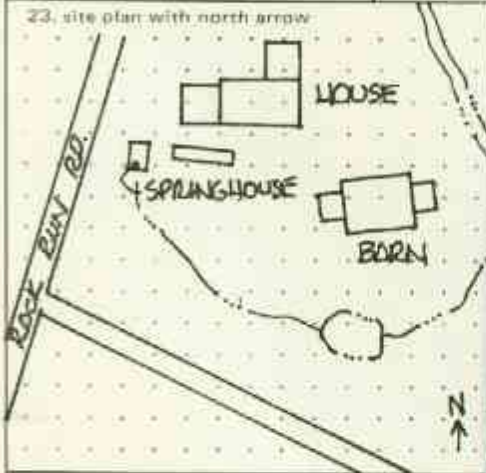

Four bays wide, two story, wood shingled gable roof farmhouse with plain stack double chimneys at both gable ends. The rough stone foundation supports a symmetrical facade with a cornice that has decorative gougework on the cornice board in place of dentil molding. Other components include plain window frames, square windows in the gables and evidence of a pent roof. The wing appears to be older than the core and is two stories high. There is also a barn and springhouse on the property.
