Describe present and historic physical appearance.

The American/Consolidated Tobacco Companies is comprised of two contributing tobacco warehouses dating from 1907 (south building) and c. 1910 (north building). The buildings, of brick laid in common bond over stone foundations, are parallel to each other on an east-west axis, separated by about twenty-five feet. In the area between the buildings each has a large loading dock. The south building, three stories in height with a raised basement, is approximately 70 feet wide by 220 feet deep. A three-story addition, c. 1925, at the west end of the building is an estimated 80 feet square; the original building and the addition total 300 feet in depth, reaching the western boundary of the lot. The south building has a flat roof with stone copings and brick corbelled cornices; window openings are brick segmental arches with rectangular six-over-six sash. The north building, originally one story, is now two stories in height. It is approximately 50 feet wide by 200 feet deep; with its rear addition it is also now 300 feet in depth. The north building has a roof of varying pitches: flat with stone copings and corbelled cornices at the easterly end; a pitched skylight, now covered with sheet metal, at the center portion; and a shed-type slightly sloping roof on the rear addition. The window openings on the north building vary: the east elevation and the first bay of the north elevation have brick segmental arch openings with paired one-over-one sash; other openings, originally for large industrial-type windows, have been reduced by brick infill to small openings having two side-by-side lights. A copper hood-overhang has been added, c. 1975, above the office entrance on the east elevation. The nominated property is situated at the southwest corner of North Prince and West Ross Streets. The surrounding area is mixed light industrial, commercial, and residential. A building materials supply company is to the immediate west and south. To the northwest is a complex of tobacco manufacture and storage buildings (see National Register nomination, Eisenlohr/Bayuk Tobacco Historic

District, submitted 1990). The American/Consolidated Tobacco Companies buildings have been in continuous operation for the same purpose since they were built. Although there have been some alterations, particularly to the north building, they have overall very good integrity.

The south building, according to the 1912 Sanborn map, is of fire proof construction, built with concrete floors and roof. Fire walls divide the building into three tobacco warehouse areas. At the northeast and southeast corners of the building are brick piers on adjoining walls which end midway between the second and third story levels. Each pier is topped by a brick-filled or false window framed with stone or artificial stone pedimented trim and sills. Across the east elevation, beneath the cornice, is a band of decorative brickwork with corner blocks of the same material as the window trim; the band surrounds a concrete-covered rectangular space, possibly covering an early sign. It is a large industrial building--the only decorative elements being the brick trim of the cornices, segmental arches, and the brickwork on the east elevation and adjacent corners. The east elevation faces North Prince Street; for the most part it is a brick wall, relieved only by the brickwork across the top and the accents of Classicism of the piers and around the false windows. These windows may have originally had glass insets to light stairways at either corner. The north elevation has numerous windows and doorways; affixed to the exterior is a wide wooden overhang and a network of wooden platforms at each level with stairs and railings, ending at the rear addition. The south elevation has six-over-six windows, some of which are filled in. At the west end of the building is the three-story brick addition over a raised basement. It has industrial-type windows, many of which are also bricked in. The south building, with the exception of the rear addition, appears little changed from when it was built in 1907. It is presently used for the storage of chewing tobacco and is a U. S. Customs and bonded warehouse.

The north building, originally one story in height, was built to house the company office at its east end; the remainder of the building was used as packing rooms, above which were skylight windows. Around 1925 the building was raised to two full stories, also with skylights (now covered), and the rear

two-story addition was built at the west elevation for the packing and shipping of tobacco. The company office is still located at the east end of the building, fronting on North Prince Street; the remainder of the building is used to store tobacco. A hanging sign at the north end of the east elevation and an affixed sign on the easterly corner of the north elevation identify the property as that of the Domestic Tobacco Co. A second affixed sign above the first bay of the north elevation points to the neighboring company. At the extreme west end of the north building on the neighboring lot is an adjoining one-story building.

The American/Consolidated Tobacco Companies buildings are functional utilitarian buildings, still serving their original purpose. Although the north building has been somewhat altered to meet changing needs in the tobacco business, the buildings have generally very good integrity.

State significance of property, and justify criteria, criteria considerations, and areas and periods of significance noted above.

The American/Consolidated Tobacco Companies nominated buildings are significant under criteria A and C. They are members of the tobacco processing and manufacturing property type under the multiple property nomination: Tobacco Buildings in Lancaster City. They are significant as an integral part of one of Lancaster City's most important late-nineteenth and early-twentieth century industries, the processing and storage of cigar leaf tobacco. They are representative of a large body of industrial buildings in the city in the early twentieth century. The buildings are very good examples of the large, long, generally flat-roofed tobacco buildings associated with this property type during the first quarter of the twentieth century (see also National Register nomination, Eisenlohr/Bayuk Tobacco Historic District, submitted 1990, Buildings G, H, I).

In 1907 the Federal Cigar Real Estate Co. purchased from Eastern Real Estate Co. two adjoining lots of land totaling 1 acre and 549/1000 of an acre at the southwest corner of North Prince and West Ross Streets (West Ross was not yet opened). The tract had been made up of purchases from (1) the Long Park Commissioners and the Henry Long Association; and (2) Benjamin J. Davis. A site plan filed with the 1907 deed shows only a house, barn, and outbuildings on the property.

In 1907 the Federal Cigar Real Estate Co., of which American Cigar Co. was a subsidiary, built the south building, a tobacco warehouse. Around 1910 the company built the north building at the corner of North Prince and West Ross Streets. The company office was at the easterly corner, the same location as at present, and the remainder of the building was packing rooms.

Both buildings were shown on the 1912 Sanborn map as being occupied by the American Cigar Co. To the northwest was the newly-built Otto Eisenlohr & Bros. Tobacco Resweating Co. (see the aforementioned National Register nomination, Eisenlohr/Bayuk Tobacco Historic District, Buildings A, B, C). Railroad sidings served both companies, with one siding extending along the north elevation of the south building.

American Cigar Co. was still listed in the Lancaster City Directory as the occupant of the buildings in 1920. On 30 November 1920 there was a voluntary dissolution of the Federal Cigar Real Estate Corp. by the trustees, most of whom were from New York. The land and buildings were sold or transferred to American Cigar Co. On 2 January 1923 Consolidated Cigar Corp., a leader in the manufacture of cigars with principal offices in New York City, received a twenty-one year lease from American Cigar Co. According to the lease, Consolidated Cigar Corp. paid \$17,000 annually for the use of the buildings for the sorting and storage of leaf tobacco and sale of cigars and cigarettes.

The 1912 (updated to 1947) Sanborn map describes this pair of warehouses as Consolidated Cigar Corporation's Lancaster Plant. The north building had been raised to two full stories by this time and rear additions had been made to both buildings (probably done about the time the property was leased by Consolidated). It was noted on the map that the south building had been constructed in 1907.

In 1972 A. Kenneth Mann, owner of other tobacco interests in Lancaster City, purchased this property from the owners at that time, Consolidated Cigar Corp. and Gulf and Western Industries, Inc. The two tobacco buildings are now part of Domestic Tobacco Co., a division of Mann Tobacco Co., owned by the Mann Estate. This company and Lancaster Leaf (Buildings A through J in the

aforementioned Eisenlohr/Bayuk Tobacco (~~Historic~~ District) are the last two operating historic tobacco industry properties in Lancaster City.

The American/Consolidated Tobacco Companies buildings are intact industrial-type tobacco warehouses built at the height of the period of significance of the tobacco industry in Lancaster City. They are examples of the large, long buildings beginning to be constructed at that time. They were designed specifically for the tobacco processing and storage needs of a large corporation with out-of-town ownership. In contrast to the earlier locally-owned tobacco warehouses which were small buildings often at the rear of lots, this pair of buildings, fronting on a main street and of fireproof construction (south building), signaled the growing importance of Lancaster City's tobacco processing industry and the increasing involvement of national cigar companies in that industry.

**Verbal Boundary Description**

Beginning at a point, the southwest corner of N. Prince and W. Ross Streets; thence extending west a distance of 300 feet along the south right-of-way of W. Ross Street and the northern property line of 820-830 N. Prince Street to a point; thence extending south a distance of 181.7 feet along the western property line of 820-830 N. Prince Street to a point; thence extending east a distance of 300 feet along the southern property line of 820-830 N. Prince Street and the north line of a right-of-way to a point, a corner of the property line of 820-830 N. Prince Street and the west right-of-way of N. Prince Street; thence extending north a distance of 181.3 feet along the property line of 820-830 N. Prince Street and the west right-of-way of N. Prince Street to the place of beginning. Being 1.5 acres.

**Boundary Justification**

The legal boundaries which are historically associated with the property. Approximately 300 feet by 14 feet along the south course of the property was deeded in 1972 as a right-of-way (unnamed alley) to the property abutting to the south, accounting for the difference in acreage from the deed of 1907 (1.59 acres); see Lancaster County Deed Book D63: 310-315 (November 1972). See also Lancaster County Tax Assessment Plat Book, District No. 33, Ward No. 9, Map No. 12J12C, Block No. 2, Lot No. 9, at the Lancaster County Tax Assessor's Office, Lancaster County Court House, Lancaster, PA.
