

Transit Agencies Cannot Purchase Equipment, Construct Facilities Due to Funding Gap-Updated August 1, 2010

When the General Assembly passed Act 44 of 2007, revenue was expected to help transit agencies purchase equipment and construct or improve facilities. Now that Act 44 revenue is cut in half, these agencies will have to delay equipment purchases and may need to cut service until additional funding is identified.
